



Game Wristband Poker Win \$300 Cash!!!! Rules of the Game!

1. Buy a Game Wristband • All prize games take a Game Wristband to WIN!
2. At registration, when you pick up your Game Wristband, you will be given (3) Three Cards. All cards are drawn one at a time. If two or more cards are drawn out of the bag, you must put them all back in the bag and draw one card over again. This is to prevent a player from choosing one card over another.
3. You will be asked to **immediately** sign each card with a sharpie. Any alterations to a card or signature disqualify the card. The card will also be **immediately** signed by the person distributing the card(s) in the **same** ink color.
NOTE: Any ball straddling where the fringe and green meet is considered on the green

4. **EARN ADDITIONAL CARDS!** At holes #3, #7, #13, #16 (Par Three) plus Hole #14 (Special Olympics Hole) you will earn a card (draw one card only from the bag) to add to your hand if you land the ball on the green in **One** (1) shot.

Hole number #14 is the Special Olympics hole and requires a donation to shoot from 150 Yards. All donations at that hole benefit Special Olympics.

NOTE: Any ball straddling where the fringe and green meet is considered on the green

5. Available on the course at each of the Par-3 and Special Olympics (Closest to the Pin) holes will be the opportunity to purchase additional cards; **One** (1) card for \$10 or **Three** (3) cards for \$20! Draw them and sign them one at a time (See rules #2 and #3 – about drawing and signing cards).
6. All cards must be signed with your signature at time of purchase.
7. Make your best Poker Hand and bring it to the club house scorer's table when you turn in with your Score Card.
8. All hands must be submitted by **5:45 PM**. Winner will be determined, and prize awarded at **6:00 PM**. Any alteration to a signature or card on a submitted hand disqualifies the **entire** hand.
9. Winning hands are determined by the chart published on Pokerology.com under "Poker Hand Rankings"

10. **ANY** alteration to signatures or cards disqualifies hand.
11. In the event of a tie, the pot will be split evenly.
